Many of you have been praying for our Bible studies with unbelievers. It's wonderful seeing people begin to realize what Jesus did for them and open their hearts up to Him. A year ago after Sheri went through her heart surgery she was able to walk alongside a woman who also had to go through heart surgery. We shared Christ with her in the hospital in Missoula when both of us had follow up visits. Missoula is four hours away and only God could have put the visits together that far away at the same time when our surgeries were over a month apart. Out of this time we offered to do a Bible study with her and she said yes. Her friend and daughter, both believers, also attended the Bible Study, but she can't seem to understand what it means to accept Christ and have a relationship with Him. We continue to work on converting the barn to a church & youth center. It seems at times we are moving at a snail's pace but God is sovereign in this as well. Last summer the folks in our church determined to take one Saturday a month to work on the barn. In doing so we completed the work on one side of the barn with repairs and siding. Not only did God bring in extra help for the week of VBS but several volunteers came various times to do some of the preliminary work. It was exciting to see how all the folks involved were excited about being able to use the gifts God has given them. Praise God for how he provided the workers and the finances for this ministry once again! Sheri was thrilled to hear all the VBS teachers and even the volunteers clearly sharing the gospel message. Families generally don't stay around for assemblies, but many unchurched and unsaved family members stayed. At the beginning of the week it was hard to see one child go hide and eat as fast as he could and as much food as he could. By the end of the week he knew that he would not be deprived food and was fed both physically and spiritually.

There is a new trend in the valley. Commitment has always been hard for people here but we are facing a new challenge. Folks go to three or four different churches at one time. They may attend our church once a month while attending the other three. Trying to help people understand commitment is a challenge. No commitment to a church means no commitment to the ministries within the body of Christ and no real spiritual growth in their lives. Pray for a work of God's Spirit.
